



House to Home: (on call)

From a families' move out to the next families' move in

Home Cleaning Team (5-15): Prepare apartments between residents through basic cleaning - Group leaders receive a simple checklist

Home Skilled Labor Team (requires experience)

- Light Repairs Team (1-2): weather stripping, replacing fixtures, drywall patching etc
- Painting Team (1-5) : *Professional experience required:* Transform a previously used apartment into a fresh, clean slate for a new family.

Home Welcome Essentials Team (Any size): Shop for household basics (bedding, cleaning supplies, kitchenware) and assemble baskets to help new families settle in. Custom lists provided for each family's unique needs.

Home Setup Team (2-5): Transform empty apartments into beautiful, cozy homes. Tasks include making beds, hanging curtains, arranging furniture, and setting up kitchen and bathroom spaces. Group leaders get a simple checklist.

Want to Work with Your Hands Outdoors? (seasonal)

Great for individuals or small crews who enjoy outdoor projects

Mowing Team (Any size): Help keep our outdoor areas safe and beautiful at The Village and McKamey Place. Experience with walk-behind or zero-turn mowers is needed for mowing, but weed eating and edging are welcome too.

Outdoor Refresh Team (up to 40): Help keep our outdoor areas safe and beautiful at The Village and McKamey Place through weeding, trimming, edging, refreshing garden beds, and more.

Support Kids + Families (always open)

Background check required.

Youth: Tutoring + Enrichment (1-5): Support youth in reading, academics, and confidence-building through structured learning or play-based activities. *(summer + after school opportunities)*

Youth: Mentorship (1-5): Walk alongside kids in an ongoing, relational way—offering encouragement, presence, and trust. *(summer + after school opportunities)*

Youth: Childcare (1-3): Help support moms as needed when there are village events such as leadership team meetings, moms meeting their allies for the first time, etc.

Youth: Group Opportunity (5-8): Come with a group on a Thursday or Friday to buddy up and play group

games outside. *(summer + after school opportunities) *adults only**

Youth: Paid Internship (1–3): AfterSchool (August–May) or Summer (June–July)

Families/Moms: Ally Teams (1–2): Walk alongside a family for monthly check-ins, encouragement, and community-building. Perfect for individuals or couples who want to invest relationally over a longer period of time.

- **Phone Calls (1-2):** Thank new donors for their support and invite them to our Cost of Thriving
- **Misc Office Tasks (1-2):** update next step housing lists for families, organize google drive files, or other needs that arise!

Mailing Team (up to 12): Preparing and sending letters (folding + stamping) during our yearly campaigns

Special Events Team (10-15): Help us out at our big events throughout the year - Greet people at our luncheon, help them park, or help us set up tables- etc!

Media Support (1–2): Use your professional or semi-professional photography or videography skills to help us capture high-quality images and videos that reflect the strength and stories of families at TRH.
